Closing Date for Entries:

Wednesday, 03 November 2021 for exhibitors. All cage labels will be couriered to exhibitors to ease the congestion during benching and to make the flow of the benching process more convenient for exhibitors and the show management team, according to the directive sent out by BSSA management committee.

Please ensure that you confirm with the Show Secretary that your entries have been received. We will not take responsibility for any unconfirmed or missing entries.

Late entries after closing date:

Late entries will be accepted until Wednesday, 10 November 2021, in which case cage labels will have to be collected at the show venue, during the set benching times as stipulated below.

COVID regulations as per the Government gazette, Vol 633, No. 43725 on 18 September 2020

Further to the Directive sent out by BSSA on 23 August 2021, please note the following relevant to Covid regulations and sanitizing:

- A sanitized carpet will be placed at the entrance of the hall. Please ensure you wipe your feet on this carpet before entering the hall.
- Judges are required to wipe the judging stick, or any other object used to assist birds
 in perching when moving from cage to cage. Sanitizing wipes to be provided. It is
 advised that judges have more than one judging stick to allow for the one that is
 sprayed to dry before re-use.
- Spraying of both hands with Virokill or disinfectant approved by BSSA before
 handling of any birds for whatever reason. Disinfectant to be used after each bird has
 been handled. This applies to approved photographers and show officials checking
 rings.
- Any food for distribution to attendees or for sale is to be pre-packed and sealed.
- All drinks for attendees or for sale must be in sealed cans or bottles.

Every person attending the show, in order to limit exposure to Covid-19, must:

- Wear a face mask at all times. A **NO MASK NO ENTRY** rule will be in place
- Adhere to any other health protocols and maintain social distancing of at least one and a half meters from each other
- Register at the entrance to the venue by completing the form provided
- Sanitize both hands with Virokill or disinfectant approved by BSSA every time the show venue is entered
- No eating or drinking will be allowed in the show venue
- Visitors and Club members not complying with Covid regulations will be formally addressed and birds entered could be disqualified
- Members not adhering to this Directive could be suspended for up to two (2) shows

Any Covid Protocol rules may be added or removed, depending on the Lockdown level and the Disaster Management Law of South Africa as per the Government Gazette.

Benching Times:

As per the directive issued by the BSSA MC, benching times will be as follows on Friday, 12 November 2021:-

 Intermediates
 15:00 to 16:00

 16:00 to 17:00

 Late arrivals
 17:00 to 18:00

Birds will only be accepted on Saturday morning, 13 November 2021, between 07:15-8:00, but only if the exhibitor is unable to bench on Friday. Exhibitor must please advise the Show Secretary telephonically before 19:00 on Friday evening, 12 November 2021. The class and exhibit numbers of the birds that will not be benched must be provided on Friday evening by no later than 19:00 in order for show documents to be printed and prepared for the show.

All show cages entering any part of the show venue must be sprayed. The BSSA MC does not recommend the spraying of birds by anyone else but the exhibitor, as the uncontrolled spraying of birds may lead to controversy. Exhibitors must please bench their own exhibits, except where exhibits are being flown in, these will then be benched by Officials available. Due to Covid, there will be no facilities available for de-spotting and preparing of birds. Exhibitors to ensure that preparation is done before arriving at the show venue.

Birds sent by Air to George Airport

Please contact the Transit Manager, **Paul Visser 063 649 1974** if you wish to send birds by air and ensure that **payment for the return flight is made in advance** together with your entry fee. Proof thereof must be sent to the Show Secretary in order to ensure the return flight can be arranged accordingly.

Briefing of stewards: All members wishing to steward must to be at the hall for briefing at

08:00 on Saturday, 13 November 2021

Judging: Will commence at 08:30 on Saturday 13 November 2021

Prize Giving: To be held once processing has been completed by the Show Secretary

on Saturday, 13 November 2021, after final judging of the Majors has

been done.

Special Request:

If you know of a member of your club who wishes to enter birds but did not receive a show catalogue and entry form, please be kind enough to make him/her a copy of the schedule and entry form. Club Secretaries are requested to please inform their members of this show.

For Sale:

There will be a "For Sale" section available. All birds to be brought in a standard show cage. Pairs can also be sold, but a maximum of 1 pair per cage please.

Show hours for visitors:

Due to Covid restrictions, no spectators will be permitted in the show venue during judging. Only appointed Judges, Stewards and Officials will be allowed in the show venue.

All Officials must wear a name tag with their official capacity stated thereon, which will be provided by the Show Secretary. Stewards must be pre-selected before the show, and it is therefore requested that all exhibitors that will be attending the show to please complete the entry form and submit these with your show entries and indicate whether you will be available to steward on the day. Name tags will be provided by the Show Secretary.

De-benching Times:

As per the directive issued by the BSSA MC, de-benching times will be as follows on Saturday, 13 November 2021 after judging of majors has taken place:-

- De-benching sheets will be available from the Show Secretary
- At the announcement that de-benching may commence, exhibitors may collect their birds according to the roster as set out below
- No exhibits may be removed from the staging prior to the official announcement that debenching may commence.
- Exhibitors are requested NOT to remove any exhibit from the staging prior to the official announcement that de-benching may commence.

Regulations

- 1. The Show Rules and Show Schedule of the Budgerigar Society of South Africa shall apply.
- 2. Birds entered in wrong classes are entirely the responsibility of the exhibitor. Entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fee will not be accepted. Entry fees will be forfeited in respect of birds not benched. NO ALTERATIONS WILL BE ALLOWED ON ENTRY FORMS AFTER RECEIPT BY THE SHOW SECRETARY BUT ADDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE IF ACCOMPANIED BY THE RELEVANT FEES.
- 3. The officials will ensure that all exhibits are properly cared for but will not, however, be responsible for any loss of, or damage to the birds or cages that may occur for any reason whatsoever either during the show or in transit to and from the show. Whilst extreme care and attention will be paid to the exhibits whilst at the show, exhibits are entered at owner's risk.
- 4. No person shall be allowed to remove from the staging any exhibit except with the permission and in the presence of the Show Manager. This rule will apply throughout the duration of the show.
- 5. Photographing of exhibits by spectators is permissible but under no circumstances may the exhibit or the show cage be touched or removed from the staging. If an official photographer is appointed for the purpose of taking photographs for publication, he/she may move the exhibit to a safe room and transfer it into a photographic cage but only in consultation with the Show Manager who will delegate a steward to assist.
- 6. Only show officials and members of the BSSA Management Committee will be allowed to move freely in the hall whilst judging is in progress. However, space allowing, spectators will be allowed to move around in the hall to view the birds on the staging but the judging area, in which only show officials and members of the Management Committee will be allowed, will be cordoned off.
- 7. Smoking and the use of alcoholic drinks in the vicinity where judging is taking place is strictly forbidden. Anybody contravening this regulation will be reported to the Show Manager and the BSSA Representative and will be removed from the show.

Standard for Show Cages

Show cages that do not comply to the standard as detailed in Appendix F and G annexed to the Rules framed in terms of the BSSA Constitution (Volume 2), will not be accepted.

1. Wooden Show Cage

- 1.1. All exhibits benched with unmarked plastic **fingerdraw drinkers** fitted to the show cages between the 1st and 2nd vertical wires on the left-hand side when facing the cage and resting on the 2nd horizontal bar from the bottom of the wire front!!!
- 1.2. All exhibits benched with blue unmarked plastic fountain drinkers fitted to the show cages in the 2nd vertical wires from the left perch when facing the cage and resting on the 2nd horizontal bar from the bottom of the wire front!!!

2. Wire Show Cage

- 2.1. All exhibits benched with blue unmarked plastic **fountain drinker** as supplied by the Society to be fitted to the back of the show cage between the 8th and 9th vertical wires counting from the left, resting on the 2nd horizontal bar from the bottom.
- 2.2. All exhibits benched with white plastic unmarked **fingerdraw drinker** to be fitted to the back of the show cage between the 8th and 9th vertical wires counting from the left, resting on the 2nd horizontal bar from the bottom can be used. The back of the show cage is the opposite side to the BSSA logo printed on the left bottom of the tray.
- 3. ONLY PLAIN CLEAR WATER WITH NO ADDITIVES MUST BE USED IN DRINKERS BEFORE JUDGING.
- 4. Show cage floors shall be covered with only a combination of three (3) seeds namely Canary seed, White millet seed and Jap millet seed PLUS optionally Oats or Grouts and no sand or sawdust may be used. No coloured water will be allowed in the drinkers

Bio-Security

The BIO- Security precautions as communicated in the BSSA Minutes of 23 August 2021 has been adjusted as follows:

The club hosting the show to provide Virokill or any other disinfectant approved by BSSA. Exhibitors must spray their own exhibits before benching commences.

All staging namely, show staging, designated area staging, judges stands, benching area stands as well as any benching and steward tables and chairs in the venue to be sprayed with Virokill or any other disinfectant approved by BSSA by the designated staging manager, before any birds enter the hall. Judges' wipes must be provided and senior stewards to ensure judges make use of the wipes as done in the past. All persons entering the hall must have both hands sprayed before they are

permitted to enter.
